Mission

Research : Conception and conduction of research projects studying meal perception and liking as well as food behaviour of various populations. Contribution and discussion of theoretical cognitive models. Scientific publications ; Applied recommendations to industry, food service, public health...

Teaching: Supervision of Master students. Participation to Phd supervision committees. Contribution to doctoral workshops and to the scientific life of the research center.

Profile

PhD in Food science with a focus on cognition or PhD in Cognitive psychology with a focus on food. A post doctoral experience is a plus.
