- University: University of Copenhagen, Denmark
- Course: European MSc programme in Sensory Science in cooperation with Wageningen University
- Course code: -
- Credits: 120 ECTS in total
- Language: English
- Instructor: Wender Bredie, professor.
- When: Courses in the European MSc programme start in September in Wageningen to be followed by courses in Copenhagen which start in February.
- Content: A unique feature of this programme is that all students get the strengths of each university during the first year of study: first five months at Wageningen University (WU) and subsequently five months in University of Copenhagen (LIFE). The second year comprises of internship/individual assignment (3-4 months) and thesis (6-7 months) at WU or LIFE.
- In the first year of the programme, you will study the principles of sensory science and instrumental sensory science as well as product properties, consumer wishes and advanced statistics for nutritionists at WU. LIFE will follow up with a course on advanced sensory methods and sensometrics and give insight in food preferences and physiology of eating. At the end of this first year, a thematic, cross-disciplinary course will combine the different theories with training in practical project work at LIFE.
- In the second year of the programme, you will perform individual, academic research as a part of the MSc thesis. More alternatives at WU and LIFE are available and you can shape the size of your own thesis project. You will also have the opportunity to work with important industries and institutions in Europe.
- Throughout the entire programme, practical exercises are important to support the scientific understanding. The courses offered by WU and LIFE will be complementary, resulting in an international experience for you.
